#### **1621E Village Fete**

- To consider the type of attractions and arrangements

The Assistant Clerk asked Councillors which attractions they would like to invite to the Village Fete. It was agreed to allow BWJFC to do their usual catering stall and Councillors discussed other catering alternatives. The Assistant Clerk made a note of other attractions required such as children's rides, pony rides, car show, fire brigade etc. The Clerk and Assistant Clerk agreed to look into new suggestions.

It was suggested a soapbox car making competition but Councillors did not think this would be popular enough.

Cllr Bowler asked if the Council would consider inviting the fair back but it was felt that this was not appropriate in view of past problems.

As The Centre will not be open in time for the Fete a licence will be required to serve alcohol on the field.

- To agree charges for participants

The charges were discussed and it was proposed that the charges for 2018 be:

Catering - £120

Trade Stalls - £30

Craft Stalls - £15

Charity Stalls - £5

RESOLVED: That the charges for the 2018 Village Fete be set as listed above.

## **1622E Working Party**

The Clerk asked which Councillors would like to be involved in the working party and suggested that the Assistant Clerk lead this group as she does the majority of the organising.
