### **1631E Public question time (20 minutes)**

There were no members of the public in attendance.

Cllr Saxton informed Councillors that a hand rail would be fitted to the new steps on Brinsworth Lane in the next week.

Cllr Williams informed the meeting that Porsche (Sheffield) had offered a driving experience prize for the Parish Council to raffle off.

## 1638E Working Party

- To receive an update on the Remembrance Weekend

Minutes of the working party meeting held had been sent out to Councillors. The Assistant Clerk went through the minutes to clarify the suggestions made to those Councillors not present. Councillors discussed the proposals.

- To consider and approve the budget

The estimated additional costs of holding the events was shared and discussions around what could be afforded followed. Some of the members of the working party felt unhappy that some Councillors did not feel that the Parish Council could support the additional costs at the present time.

The Clerk didn't feel that she was in a position to offer advice on whether the additional budget was available at this stage. The year end accounts are still to be completed and the cost of projects already committed to need to be added into the 2018/19 budget before she can offer any advice. The Clerk was hopeful that she would be in a position to do so at the next events meeting.

Cllr Buckley thanked the Events working party members for their hard work and reassured them that it hadn't been a waste of their time. He then suggested that the draft budget for the project be circulated to all Councillors for them to digest, consider and prioritise ideas should the funding not be available.
