1651E Village Fete

1st July 2018

The Clerk and Assistant Clerk gave feedback on the Fete for Councillors. It was thought that the Fete had been quieter than in previous years possibly due to other big events in the area happening on the same day. Overall feedback received from those that had attended was positive with only a few negative comments being reported such as queues for food, prices of ice-creams and too many charity stalls. The Clerk informed Councillors that one of the catering outlets had been very late in setting up and people were waiting to be served food. Councillors agreed that local ice cream providers should be sourced for 2019.

The Clerk reported that the Prosecco Van owner had wrote to her to thank the attendants for their help getting his van running, without their help he would not have been able to stay, he also expressed his wish to return in 2019. Nonna's Pizza van had been positively received and again have already said they would like to return.

The Car show saw 66 cars attend which were judged by the public and the Mayor. Sheffield Dubs who arranged the show said that they had an enjoyable day and would be more than happy to arrange another show for the Parish Council. They have suggested that the takings from the show be donated to a local charity.

AJ Entertainment who provided the sound system for the Fete has offered to arrange a 5 aside football tournament for 2019.

The Clerk suggested that the date for next year's Fete should be agreed as soon as possible so that she can notify those who have expressed an interest and get them provisionally booked and a review of charges should be carried out to encourage more businesses to attend.
