On Saturday the children's rides and catering units will be in the Centre car park and will be on site by 2.00 pm. The Fireworks, beacons and search lights would arrive at

Remembrance Sunday will start with a service in the Centre at 9.45am followed by a parade to the War Memorial for the Remembrance Service at 10.45am. A poppy wreath and 80 car poppies had been bought to represent the 79 names of WW1 and WW2 soldiers and one poppy for the Boar War Soldier. The Assistant Clerk was thanked for arranging these. Refreshments will be served back at the Centre by Friends of St George's Churchyard and the bar will be open.
