1700E Public question time (20 minutes)

There were no members of the public in attendance.

1701E Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllrs Buckley, Hughes, Ridge, Tompkins and Williams and the reasons given were approved.

1703E Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on:-

1705E Village Fete

An action plan that the working party has put together was circulated to Councillors and Cllr Barry went through the details. The working party are working to a deadline date of the 25th June 2019 to have all the plans in place. A schedule of meetings to the run up of the Fete have been set and tasks have been delegated to the relevant officer to progress.

Councillors discussed the proposals and the Clerk was asked to include an item on a future agenda to choose the project that any donations would be put towards.

1706E Civic Service

The Clerk asked Councillors to consider what entertainment they would like to see at this years Civic Service.

It was agreed that last years choir was extremely well received and that Rev Margaret Baker should be approached to ensure she was available to deliver the service and to enquire if the Rivers Team Choir would like to be involved. Rev Baker also needs to be asked about the Remembrance Service.

RESOLVED: That the Clerk find out if the Rivers Team are able to play a part in the Civic Service this year.

1707E Other Events

- To receive information regarding the Litter Pick organised with RMBC Neighbourhoods and approve the purchase of a small Easter Egg for the young participants.

The Clerk informed Councillors that RMBC had approached the Parish Council in regards putting together a litter pick day to support the Keep Britain Tidy Spring Clean campaign. A date has been set for the 17th April 2019 and RMBC are to supply the litter picking kit that can be kept by the Parish Council for future events. Easter eggs are to be offered to try and encourage families to take part in the event and are to be provided by the Parish Council subject to approval. A suitable place to do the litter pick still needs to be set, the Clerk is waiting until the week of the event to see which areas are in most need of the attention

RESOLVED: That the litter pick is an excellent idea and has the Parish Councils backing and the Easter Eggs can be purchased.
