#### **1776E Apologies**

**1783E Circus**

RESOLVED: That approval is given for Pinders Circus to hire Brinsworth Playing Fields in May 2021.

**1784E Newsletter**

The Clerk asked Councillors whether they wished to produce a newsletter, she suggested that a shortened version could be put together informing residents of all the things that had happened in the village since Covid19 struck and also relaunch The Centre.

Cllr Saxton thought it was a good idea as it would show the public that the Council has still been active through this period and the Council could share all the good things that had been happening such as the hot food project.

The Chairman asked the Clerk what timescales she was suggesting and taking into account annual leave she thought a delivery of the end of September was possible but would need to check with Chameleon Publications for their availability.

The Clerk asked Councillors if they wished to lay a wreath to commemorate VJ Day which was on the 15th August 2020. Councillors agreed this was a good idea and should be kept low key due to Covid19.
