764P Apologies

768P Update on Bookings

a) To receive an update on regular and one-off bookings for the Pavilion

The Clerk reported that the Parish Council have been approached by an inflatable slide company who wish to use the Playing Fields to test their equipment.

Get Fit Get Focused who run the 'Young at Heart' sessions in the Centre are to start Family Boot Camp sessions on a Sunday morning using the Playing Fields, initially on a 3 week trial period to test demand.

b) To receive an update on regular and one-off bookings for the Centre

An up to date calendar of events had been circulated prior to the meeting.

The Clerk informed Councillors that the friends and family of the young man fatally injured over the Easter holidays were fund raising in order to buy something in his memory. The Clerk was aware that his friends would like something in his memory on the Brinsworth Playing Fields but she has not been approached with an official request.

772P Funtime Pre-School *

a) To receive an update on the financial position

The Clerk reported that she had received the accounts from the Committee of Funtime and expressed her concerns that some of the costs in the budget forecast are to be covered by fundraising which isn't a usual accounting practice. From the accounts it is difficult to see how the preschool can continue to operate beyond July.
