**844P Apologies**

Apologies have been received from Cllr Mrs K Saxton and the reasons given were approved.

**845P Declaration of Members Interests**

The Chairman asked Councillors to express any declarations of interest prior to the relevant item being discussed.

**846P Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on:-**

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the meeting held on the 13th February 2020 are a true and accurate record.

**847P To receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action where necessary**

839P (831P) - The Clerk reported that Dinnington College will possibly be unable to complete the bowling shelters due to the closure of its campus but may be able to get us the timber required at a discounted rate.

839P (832P) - The Clerk reported that the new play equipment has been installed and a site visit has been requested to deal with a few snagging issues. The Clerk also informed Councillors that a significant amount of bark has been purchased to back fill the area as it hasn't been done for some time.

839P (833P) - The Clerk reported that the 3 new dog bins have been installed and are being emptied by the Attendants. They have reported that they are being well used.

841P - The Bowling Club have been informed of the small price increase and no feed back has been received.

842P - Tree Maintenance work has started on Millennium Park, Brinsworth Playing Fields work will commence when the fields are accessible.

**848P Update on Bookings**

- To receive an update on regular and one-off bookings

The Clerk updated Councillors with the list of regular bookings and private hirers. She informed Councillors that due to the current Corona Virus emergency the Pavilion may see users choosing to cancel classes or that the Parish Council may have to close the facility.

**849P Resource Centre**

- To consider and approve a request from Trustees with regards to purchasing equipment for The Centre

The Clerk read out an email from the Trustees requesting funding for 2 tills and a larger safe for the Centre. The tills are currently being hired and is not cost affective, these tills are up to date and are able to be used for stock taking and time management. The current safe is too small to be able to fit till drawers in.

Councillors discussed the request and shared their concerns.

The Clerk suggested that possible increasing the loan amount would be a more appropriate course of action and that in the licence / lease agreement that is still to be drawn up, that a clause to say all equipment remains the property of the community is included.

RESOLVED: That provided that the equipment remains the property of the community the Parish Council will increase the loan amount by £5,000 to enable the purchase of the tills and safe.

RESOLVED: That the licence / lease agreement needs revisiting to ensure the assets of The Centre remain the property of the community.

**850P Brinsworth Library**

The Clerk reported that the Library is now open to the public.
