888P Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr Mrs M Rollinson and the reason given was approved.

889P Declaration of Members Interests

The Chairman asked Councillors to express any declarations of interest either now or prior to the relevant agenda item being discussed.

890P Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on:-

885P - The Deputy Clerk informed Councillors that RMBC had still not been out to flush the drains and that she continued to chase them on a regular basis.

The Clerk informed Councillors that a flooding issue on Millennium Park had been raised by a resident following the repairs to the footpath. Both Cllrs Williams and Buckley confirmed that this had been raised in the past and that some solutions had been put in place. The Clerk said she would look into it further.

892P Field Lighting

- To discuss a request for additional lighting on Brinsworth Playing Fields and Millennium Park

The Clerk informed Councillors that this suggestion had been brought to her from Cllr Ridge who thought that Brinsworth Playing Fields could benefit from more lighting along the bottom and on the path that runs parallel with Brinsworth Lane. During the evenings this part of the field is extremely dark.

The Clerk also informed Councillors that she had received a request from residents to put lights on Millennium Park.

At this point the Clerk has done little research on the subject but asked Councillors to consider if it is something they are likely to consider.

Councillors discussed the proposal along with the pros and cons of additional lighting. Cllr Chapman suggested that a poll on social media might help to gauge the public's thoughts and Cllr Williams suggested using the next edition of the newsletter.

RESOLVED: That the Clerk look into the cost of additional lighting and put on a future agenda for discussion.

893P Pavilion Maintenance

- To discuss and approve any thoughts / ideas from Councillors regarding the repurposing of Pavilion changing rooms.

The Clerk asked Councillors if they have had anymore thoughts on how to use the former changing room space and updated Cllr Chapman on the proposal.

The Clerk felt that it would be a good idea to wait until the area had been cleared so that they can fully appreciate the space available.

The Clerk was asked to send the plans to Cllr Chapman.

The Clerk invited Cllr Chapman to visit for a guided tour of the facilities.
