894P Apologies

There were no apologies received.

895P Declaration of Members Interests

The Chairman asked Councillors to express any declarations of interest either now or prior to the relevant agenda item being discussed.

896P Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on:-

21st January 2021

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the meeting held on the 21st January 2021 are approved as a true and accurate record.

897P To receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action where necessary

891P - The Deputy Clerk informed Councillors that RMBC had paid a site visit to assess accessing the field drains for jetting. At this moment in time the field is far too wet to enable access with the machinery required and they have suggested that the work is postponed until April when the conditions can be reassessed.

892P - Field Lighting - The Clerk informed Councillors that this work has been added to the list of projects and will be added to a future agenda for discussion.

898P Pavilion Maintenance

a) To approve repairs required to the Pavilion guttering and blocked drain which is causing damp inside.

The Clerk explained to Councillors that there are several leaks in the guttering around the Pavilion and that one of the drains is also blocked which is causing problems with damp inside the Pavilion. The Clerk asked Councillors for permission to get the work completed in line with her delegated powers.

RESOLVED: That the work to repair the Pavilion guttering and blocked drain is approved.

b) To approve works required to isolate the water feed to the Bowling Green

The Clerk informed Councillors that there is currently no way of isolating the various water feeds beyond the gents toilets in the Pavilion. The Clerk suggested that separate feeds for the Library, Bowling Green and Garage were required and would help identify any future water leak issues.

RESOLVED: That the work to isolate the water feed is approved.

Cllr Saxton asked the Chairman to move standing orders.

899P Field Lighting

- To approve work required to isolate the car park lights from the MUGA and field lighting

The Clerk explained that the electricity supply to the field, car park and MUGA are currently all off one supply and this has its disadvantages during the winter months and that splitting the feed would be beneficial.

RESOLVED: That work is approved to isolate the lights on the car park, MUGA and field lights.

900P Use of Pavilion

- To receive a proposal to run a youth club for youngsters with special educational needs in the Pavilion and approve the proposal if applicable.

The Deputy Clerk informed Councillors that she has been approached by Active Regen who are working with a successful youth club for children with SEN and their families in Dinnington. Twenty Five of these families come from the Brinsworth area with plenty more families in the area looking to attend.

With funding successfully gained they want to bring the provision to Brinsworth and have asked the Parish Council if they would consider allowing them to use the Pavilion free of charge on a Friday evening.

Councillors agreed that this was an excellent idea and would meet the needs of so many local families.

RESOLVED: That approval is given to work in partnership with Active Regen to provide a weekly youth club for youngsters with special educational needs and their families in the Pavilion.
