MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 12 AUGUST 2021

2544 Public Question Time (20 minutes)

There was a member of the public in attendance who was there to observe the meeting.

Cllr Ridge had a question for Councillors from a member of the public, who had been informed by a current Parish Councillor that the area of Brinsworth not currently within the Parish boundary would soon benefit from the same services as those within the Parish without having to pay the precept, and wanted to confirm that this would not be the case. Cllr Ridge hadn't been given the name of the Councillor.

Cllr Buckley gave some background into why this part of Brinsworth wasn't within the boundary and that a consultation with residents had been undertaken and that the overwhelming response was that they did not wish to be included in the Parish boundary.

Councillors agreed that no areas of Brinsworth that do not pay into the precept will ever receive additional services from the Parish Council and Cllr Ridge was advised to pass this message back to the resident.

2545 Apologies

Apologies have been received from Cllrs Chatwyn, Hannan and Nocton and the reasons given were approved.

2549 Community Issues

a) Police - There were no police in attendance.

b) Ward Councillors - Cllr Adam Carter was in attendance and updated Councillors on projects that himself and Cllr Charlotte Carter were involved in.

Motorway Services - Objections have been submitted to the proposal on behalf of residents

and Ward Councillors welcomed the Parish Council's objection.

CLF Funding - Cllr Carter informed Councillors that work to deliver on the two joint projects with the Parish Council had started with the Clerk and a member of staff from RMBC doing research and identifying areas. The Clerk reported that Ward Councillors would be informed of the findings soon.

Weeds and overgrown hedging - Cllr Carter has been responding to residents reports of overgrown weeds and hedges in the village and working with Streetpride to address the issue. The Clerk confirmed that she had also passed on all complaints to Streetpride and copied Ward Councillors in. Cllr Watson asked if the area on Whitehill Lane that is adjacent to Highlow View could be looked at as the overgrown vegetation was getting bad and obstructing the footpath.

Blitz days on Howarth estate were planned to go ahead in September and Ward Councillors welcomed suggestions for future days.

Rotherham Early Help have arranged a water fun day for 18th August 2021 on Brinsworth Playing Fields. Ward Councillors are using the opportunity to do some face to face consultation with Brinsworth youths to see what activities / facilities they would like to see offered. The results of the consultation will also form part of the Parish Plan.

Ward Councillors have been liaising with the Police to try and drive down bullying in the area.

Ward Councillors will also be putting in comments on the proposed development on the former Howarth House site. They will be asking for the former footpath to be reinstated and a tree replacement scheme put in place.

Councillors were asked if they had any questions for Cllr Carter.

Cllr Buckley thanked Cllr Carter for the update on Howarth House and the Service Station as these were questions he had.

Cllr Buckley also asked Cllr Carter a question from a member of the public who would like to know if Ward Councillors would be holding face to face surgeries so that residents could meet with them. Cllr Carter confirmed that there were no plans to hold regular surgeries but that residents are welcome to contact himself or Charlotte to arrange a meeting if this was required.

Cllr Carter was thanked for the update.
