### MINUTES OF THE EVENTS MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 14 APRIL 2022

#### **1878E Public question time (20 minutes)**

There were no members of the public in attendance.

#### **1879E Apologies**

Apologies have been received from Cllrs Chatwyn, Jones, Nocton and Ridge and the reasons given were accepted.

#### **1880E Declaration of members' interests**

The Chair asked Members to declare any items of pecuniary or other interest either now or at the beginning of the relevant agenda item.

#### **1881E Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on:-**

17th March 2022

RESOLVED: That the minutes of the meeting held on the 17th March 2022 are approved as a true and accurate record.

#### **1882E To receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action where necessary**

There were no ongoing issues to discuss.

#### **1883E Firework Display**

- To consider and approve the costings for 5th November 2022

Prior to the meeting the Clerk had circulated the breakdown of costs for the Fireworks display.

Councillors discussed and considered whether the event should continue.

They suggested that a formal public consultation be carried out at the Village Fete and possibly on Facebook to find out what residents wanted the Council to spend the precept on. Councillors thought that this was a good idea and asked the Clerk to add this to the Village Fete plan.

The Clerk also made suggestions as to where the funding shortfall could be taken from and asked Councillors if they would like her to submit a budget review at the next Finance meeting. Councillors agreed that they would.

Cllr Gelder asked if the Fireworks display could be on the Queens Jubilee instead. The Clerk advised Cllr Gelder that due to the time of year it would be difficult to have Fireworks on this date but suggested that the theme of this year's display could be based around the Jubilee. Councillors agreed that this was a good idea.

RESOLVED: That the Fireworks display for November 2022 goes ahead on the 5th and that the theme should be based on the Queen's Jubilee, if possible.

## **1884E Working Party**

- To receive an update from the Events Working Party

The minutes of the working party were circulated to Councillors prior to the meeting.

The Clerk explained that the events arranged by the Parish Council and Trust needed to be separated and that in future events would be a standard agenda item on the Trust agenda.

Councillors went through the list of events. It was agreed that the Council would ask residents to inform them of where street parties were taking place and that a free prize of a bottle of fizz or Chocolates would be delivered to anyone who responds. The Clerk informed Councillors that this would require volunteers as many of the Parish Council staff would be away.

The Councillors also discussed options to commemorate the Jubilee as the bench was an expensive option. The Clerk suggested a plaque for one of the existing benches outside of the Library and a couple of standard Queen Elizabeth Rose bushes planted either side. Councillors agreed that this was a good idea.

RESOLVED: That bottles of fizz and chocolates are purchased to be delivered to streets taking part in the Jubilee celebrations and that a plaque for a garden bench and suitable standard roses are also purchased to commemorate the occasion.

The Clerk gave some feedback on the latest edition of the Newsletter. It was agreed that more information on items such as the the bowling green and what the Parish Council have planned need to be included in the next edition and less on what the Council has done. The next edition of the newsletter, who should produce articles and the content to be discussed at the next Events meeting.

The Clerk agreed to arrange another Events working party meeting in May and that she would ask the Centre Business Manager to arrange one for the Trust.
